On this day in 1945, Japan formally surrendered aboard the U.S.S. *Missouri* in Tokyo Bay, effectively ending WWII. The day is now known as **V-J Day**.

3
Plan a **book club discussion** on Margaret Atwood's *Hag-Seed*, a retelling of Shakespeare's *The Tempest*.

This day marks the first electric lighting in New York City, when approximately 400 lights came on in lower Manhattan after **Thomas Edison** created the world's first central power station.

Babe Ruth hit his first professional home run on this day in 1914. Share some cool facts about the Sultan of Swat.

Pull out the coffee maker and invite patrons to get cozy for **Read a Book Day**. Encourage families to pick out a book to read aloud together.

Buddy Holly was born on this day in 1936. Create a display of music and biographies of famous 1950s teen idols.

Host a **Star Trek** movie marathon and boldly go where no one has gone before with a discussion on the **science of Star Trek**. The original series premiered on NBC in 1966.

Hold a family program to make personalized **DIY painted mugs** for **National Grandparents Day**.

Create a **display of western books and movies** in celebration of the premiere of **Gunsmoke** on this day in 1955.

Little House on the Prairie premiered on this day in 1974. Check out *Smithsonian Magazine's* discussion about **the science of the well-loved story**.

"Awards become corroded, friends gather no dust." — **Jesse Owens**, born on this day in 1913. Screen the 2016 biopic **Race**, which details Owens' 1936 Olympic journey.

Have patrons submit their own lyrics for **International Country Music Day**. The **Battle of Antietam** was fought near Maryland's Antietam Creek in 1862.

The **U.S. Air Force** was established on this day in 1947 with the National Security Act signed by President Truman. An amendment in 1949 reorganized military services, bringing the USAF under the Department of Defense.

Encourage patrons to take advantage of the last of the summer sun by getting outside solo or as a family and going on a **geocaching treasure hunt** for **International Talk Like a Pirate Day**.

National Pepperoni Pizza Day sounds as good as it tastes. Share mouth-watering **homemade pizza recipes**. Host a **Game of Thrones** trivia night to celebrate the birthday of **George R.R. Martin**, born on this day in 1948.

"Together for Peace: Respect, Safety and Dignity for All" is the theme for the 2017 **International Day of Peace**. Host an evening that brings together the migrants and refugees in your community. Science-fiction writer **H.G. Wells** was born on this day in 1866.
