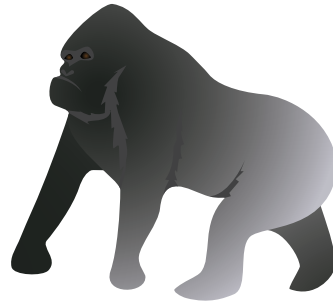

Book Title Challenge



Ivan, a silverback gorilla, is considered a primate. A primate is a mammal that can grasp with its hands and feet and has a short snout and a large brain. Primates are social animals. Monkeys, apes, gibbons, and humans are all considered primates.

Directions: For each letter in the word PRIMATE, find and write down the title of a book that begins with that letter. (Write the author's name as well.) These can be picture books, fiction books, nonfiction books, or another type of book of your choice, but all should be the same type of book.
